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GENERAL FOREIGN NEWS.

Estimates of the East Sugar Crop in the Old World.

The House of Lords on Home Rule—England Must Have Her Policy—Representative Note.

London, Sept. 6.—Data obtained from reliable sources on prospective supplies of European sugar from the crop of 1893 considerably modify the estimate of the *Argentine* planters of Brazil. Inquiry made by a representative of the Associated Press has obtained considerable expansion of opinion that all European must be taken into consideration, according to the weather there, and the crop is completed may favor or injure the trade.
