AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FOWLS TRESSPASSING. SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the City Council of Salt Lake City, That it shall be unlawful for the owner of any domestic fowls, such as tur-keys, ducks, geese or chickens, to permit such fowls to trespass upon the premises of another person at any time between the first day of March and the thirty first day of March and the thirty first day of 10 October; and any such owner, for permitting them to so tresspas, shall on conviction be liable to a fine in any sum not exceeding ten dollars.
