

# TELEGRAPHIC. RED CROSS SOCIETY

Undertakes the Task of Distributing Relief Among Armenians.

THIS STATEMENT ISSUED.

Gallies of Dollars Will Be Sended  
and the Bonds are  
Urge.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Dec. 14.—The American Red Cross Society has decided to accept the duty of distributing the relief funds for the Armenian sufferers, and has issued the following statement:

On account of the wantonness and urgent appeals from the friends of humanity, representing nearly all of the people of the country, the American National Red Cross has decided that it must accept the entire trust of endeavoring to relieve the suffering Armenians in Asia Minor. According to estimates made by the Armenian people in that country, who were here to assist us eight months—until the next harvest.

Fully realizing the difficulties and dangers to be met, the Red Cross will start for Turkey as soon as sufficient funds are at hand for the disbursements to secure its return.

Funds may be sent to Miss Clara Laine, president and treasurer of the American National Red Cross, Washington, D. C. Automobiles will be hired, horses and mares, and materials will be sent in new ways. The Red Cross also suggests that goods, funds and other material may be sent by railroad steamer.

"California," Oct. 14.—"The Red Cross has no plan of re-education for the future, but was reluctant to assume the responsibilities involved. Atkinson, the writer on Turkish questions, the needs of missionary and medical work, and the like, has been asked, as well as many men and girls of irreproachable record, to assist the Red Cross in the discharge of its duties.

Miss Harton said that the Red Cross would be unable to meet the cost of the relief funds until the fall, when the crops are harvested.

**PROTESTANTISM.**
