

**BILLIARD AND POOL ROOM EVIL**

The City Soothes Will Endeavor to Ache it by Legislation.

The ordinance submitted by City Attorney Hoge at the meeting of the Council on Friday night which is intended to abate the evil of saloon-keepers allowing minors to play billiards and pool, promises to provoke a lively discussion at the Council meeting to be held next night. The law prohibiting the sale of liquor to minors is plain enough, says the committee on police, but the saloon men get around it by selling the privilege of playing pool to children of a certain age. It is really remarkable to allow a few drinks of whisky to be "grown up."

San Francisco is contending with the same evil at the present time. A paper of that city, U. S. Hubbard, member of the California Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children, has petitioned the board of supervisors to close up a number of resort saloons, spend their earnings in the sale of the article following: "It is unlawful for any person under the age of 18 years to enter into any game of billiards, pocket pool, pin pool or cards, and it shall likewise be unlawful for any person under the age of 18 years to engage in any such game in places within the city and county of San Francisco or any proprietor, keeper, bartender or clerk, or any other person having charge or control of any saloon, bar, hotel or pool room, to permit any minor to enter into the same." The motion was carried by a vote of 10 to 9.

It is to be noted that the motion was made on the ground that the action of the saloon-keepers was calculated to permit any person under the age of 18 years to play, engage in or be present at any game of billiards, pocket pool, pin pool or cards, and it shall likewise be unlawful for any person under the age of 18 years to engage in any such game in places within the city and county of San Francisco."

**They Were Fooled.**

**A CELEBRATED SHAKER.**

Elder Evans was the head of a colony of Shakers who never quarreled.

Elder Frederick W. Evans, the celebrated Shaker, who died here at New Lebanon, N. Y., on the 1st of March, was eighty-five years old and an Englishman by birth. He came to this country in 1823. He was a brother of George H. Evans, who instigated the great land reform that helped elect Jackson as President, and who also advocated the attachment of implementation of that and other reforms. In 1830 Frederick W. Evans, then a member of Robert W. Owen's community, known as the Socialist club, visited New England to inquire into the mode of life among the Shakers. He was a member of the time, and he was a community of six hundred souls living in perfect harmony among themselves and at peace with the world.

He was so favorably impressed that he joined the community and became in the course of time a presiding elder. Under Elder Evans the community continued to thrive. He was a student, teacher, author, thinker and put his efforts to practical application. All the members of the New Lebanon community were Shakers. The heads of the settlement were Elder Evans, another elder and two sisters. No elections were ever held, all changes in administration being in accordance with what would be best for the Shakers. That is, the right men and women always seemed to land on top, increasing no rivalry.

Elder Evans and his people believed that all men were as divine as Christ. The Bible was another accepted scripture. The Shakers placed great importance on their proper and neat appearance. Elder Evans and his associates were believers in spirit and nearly all the steps they took in the affairs of the colony were in accordance with what was termed "the voice of the spirit." The spiritual ways gave them good advice, and the colony at last accounts was little given to quarreling or of vice. As a cooperative community, all working in the same mold, and the presiding elders and sisters ministering to the various wants of the colonists.

**POSTAL CARD INNOVATION.**

Communications to Europe and Reply for Four Cents.

The following information is given regarding the new postal cards designed for use between the United States and Europe:

To the card project is annexed a paid reply card which will enable a person in this country to communicate with friends in Europe and receive their correspondence gratis. The cards are a little smaller than the single ones now in use and are almost identical with the reply postal cards recently brought into use in the United States alone.

The law permitting the use of for-

warding cards was agreed upon by the members of the Universal Postal Union in Vienna. A number of European countries immediately began to introduce them, but the United States failed to avail itself of the advantage until very recently.

**THE "PICKLE" COSTER-CASE.**

Judge Zane is Against the Defendants and Imposes a Small Fine.

In the matter of the "pickle" consternation proceedings, the arguments of counsel in Judge Zane's court did not finish until a late hour on Saturday afternoon. The proceedings, it will be remembered, were instituted by Marshal Hampton against Sheriff McAllister, Deputy Sheriff O'Brien and H. Evans and W. H. Booth, as previously stated in these columns.

There was also argued a motion by the Illinois Glass company and other creditors to dismiss the attachment in the case of W. A. Chapman vs. the Salt Lake Pickle company, which was the attachment issued to the United States marshal prior to the filing of the proceedings concerning the same.

This motion was made on the ground that the attachment was clearly an attachment of the court, and that the defendants were not sheriff, out of which the proceedings concerning arose.
