



SALT LAKE CITY IN 1853.

This picture illustrates Salt Lake City as it was in 1853. It is from the head of East Temple street looking south and plainly shows Heber C. Kimball's residence, between North Temple and First North streets, and the DESERET NEWS building nearly two blocks farther south. The sections of wall to the right and left are familiar landmarks to all Salt Lake residents, being representations of the Temple and News office blocks, and like the section of the old Spanish wall, were produced for this article.
