REPORT OF THE SECRETARY OF WAR TRANSMITTED TO CONGRESS.

WASHINGTON, July 16.—The secretary of war today transmitted to Congress the report of the chief engineers on the preliminary examination made by Maj. T. W. Symonds of the corps of engineers, of a ship canal from the great lake to the Hudson river. The work was done in accordance with a provision in the last river and harbor bill.

Gen. Wilson, chief of engineers, says in the report that it is the opinion of the chief engineers that the route for a ship canal is that by way of Niagara river, Lake Ontario, Oswego, and Hudson rivers, and that the estimated cost of such a canal is \$100,000,000.

Mr. Symonds further expressed the opinion that the construction of such a ship canal is not a project worthy of being undertaken by the general government, for the reason that it is not a project which would be commensurate with its cost.
