opened today to a good demand for stocks. Orders had come in thick and fast since Saturday, as is evidenced by the heavy sales in Ajax and Victor, and the good demand for a number of other securities. Ajax opened at \$1.40 and closed at \$1.43%, after selling up to \$1.45%. Anchor let go 100 shares at \$2,50, while Con. Mercur moved up to \$2.62. Sacramento sold at 24%. Star Con, was a little weaker, selling down at the outset, but afterwards weakened to 69 and closed at 69%. Uncle Sam sold up to \$1.80 and closed at \$1.78%, while Tetro released an odd lot at 31. Victor dropped nearly 20,090 shares at prices ranging from 60 at the opening to 54. It closed a little firmer at 55%. Sunbeam sold down to 54. while Boss Tweed was active between 58 and 59, Ben Butler released several thousand shares between 191/2 and 201/4. Daly West was very active at much higher prices. With definite information released regarding the lawsuit rumors, it reacted to \$39.35 today, and closed at \$38.80.
