Review of the Stock Market for the Week Just Passed.

COAL MIXE INSPECTION'S REPORT.

The Dipper Dredge to Selden A. Thomas—Mammouth ship at—News From Salt Lake Harbor.

The week closed in change with the week ending the local mining stock market has made some of the gains of the present year. Stocks were somewhat slow for an trading day, but recovered with a reaction. The closing day, however, showed renewed activity, which was undoubtedly made business much brisker in the week to come. The aggregate sales for the week as well as shown below, was 12,100 shares, all of which had a total selling value of \$1,141.

Today's only stock with an advance bid for at 30 cents, but the stock was not offered at any figure. A few shares and received very little attention, while Bullion-Bank ran up to \$100 in the bidding, with the stock as an offering at \$10.25. Offices of Centennial-Fishery were made at \$10.25, but no outside purchases failed to put in an appearance. Four Acon stock made the first sale by reaching hands at 12 cents a share. More than a dozen of \$5 and was offered at \$7.25, while Mammouth was suddenly more than doubling the price, from \$10.25 to \$20.40 at the time. It was speculated a rise in the bidding.

A list of unlisted shares made their appearance on the market, only two of which took part in the trading. They were Northern-Lake, which sold at \$24 and \$40, and Silver, which was a seller at \$4 and \$5. The latter stock in the unlisted class received very little attention.

COAL INSPECTION'S REPORT.

Output of Utah's Coal Mines for the Past Year.

The report of Utah coal mine inspection for the year 1896 has just been issued from the office of the inspector. The total coal production for the year was 6,000,000 tons, which from 1895 to 1896 inclusive the production was 2,590,000 tons.

During the year but three fatal accidents occurred in or about the mines, resulting in the death of four persons. The first of these occurred July 28th, when Peter Jensen was killed in the Cretaceous mine. The second was on November 14th, when William Thorsen was killed in the same mine, while the third was the killing of Andrew Thorsen and Charles Anderson on November 24th, in the Cretaceous mine. The Cretaceous mine is the largest coal mine in the state, and the production of this mine is estimated to be 2,500,000 tons.
