In our not very extensive explora-tions we find this part of Arisona full of opportunities for men to haunch into the mining and stock raising business, there being some of the most extensive grass plains we ever had the pleasure of travel-ing over, also asid to be the best and most substantial mining district in this Territory. There is saw timber in the Hauchaucz and San-tasita mountains, which can be reached from the surrounding country. Bro. John W. Campbell and his bro-ther have a twenty-five horse power steam saw mill in the former moun-tains and furnish lumber (rough) at \$35.00 per 1.000 feet, also tumber can be had at Benson eight miles from here at \$55.00 per 1.000 feet, shingles \$6.00 per 1.000, Potatoes are brought from Colorado, and sold here at \$5.25 per 100 pounds, flour at \$4.00 per 100 pounds, and everything that fami-lies need at much more reason-able prices than the people of Salt River valley have to pay. Strange as it may appear, Mr. C. T. Hayden, of Tempe, fur-nishes flour of the best quality, so that it is retailed at \$4 here, while the people of Salt River Valley, who produce the whest, pay the same. This is owing to the monopoly of flouring mills. We flattered our-selves that when one of our brethren would get his mill in operation, that competition would to the farmers reduce flour. But to our mortifica-tion and sensitiveness of our pock-ets, the price remains the same, and the Latter-day Saints can plainly see
