

A COUNCIL GARNISHEE.

Lawson Says He Cannot Understand Why the Mayor and Fire Chief Should be "Enforcers" of Dead Brains.

Some time ago, it will be remembered, that Councilman Lawson garnished the wages of an employee at the fire department for a certain amount of money alleged to be due on a house occupied by the above-named employee and his family. His honor, the Mayor, apparently considered the fireman a victim of commendable ingenuity and accordingly wrote a representative and sarcastic word document to the City Council which reflected on the actions of Mr. Lawson. The reading of this paper created a sensation at the time and was highly exciting. It is true, in about the twentieth round of "fists," the excusing and arraignment, "and so on."

Finally the master was returned to Mr. Lawson as a committee of one to report back to the whole transaction. After the adjournment of the Council the document containing the charges was taken from the table by the accused councilman who proceeded to pocket it and then disappeared into the City Recorder's Office. It would certainly be an ungracious government that would shield any one from the payment of honest debts, and such a government would be entitled to no respect from honest men. That his Honor, the Mayor, and Major Stanton should appear as executors of dead rents cannot be explained. I hope on the theory that there is some kind of a personal interest between them and persons who desire the status of fugitives to run against their debts."

The First White Woman to Cross the Sierra Nevada.

Under the above caption the Mining Age of the 11th inst., contains the following story of an aged pioneer living in a cabin in the Cuyamaca mountains in San Diego county, Cal., at the age of seventy, Mrs. Benjamin Kelsey. She was the first white woman to cross the Sierra Nevada. That was in 1841, long before the gold excitement, when she was eighteen years of age.

A native of Barren county, Ky., Mrs. Kelsey moved to Missouri, where she married. With her husband and thirty-one others—all men—she started overland for the Pacific coast. In the party was a boy named John Bidwell, who was the prohibition candidate for president in the last campaign. Some of the other members of the party were Captain Webster, who founded Shoshone and became rich; Colonel Harrison, Colonel Richmond, Captain Joe Urioste; Justin Bidwell, and Charlie Hodder.

Wagons were abandoned near where Salt Lake City now stands, and the rest of the journey made on horseback. Mrs. Kelsey carried not hay in trust of her saddle. The Sierra Nevada were crossed by the members of the wagon train overland, making a circuit of about three months, arriving on August 1, 1841, which was Mrs. Kelsey's birthday. She and her husband went up to Butcher's Fort in search of Indians, and the hunting spot on Christmas day of that year. John Walker had just arrived at the fort when gold was discovered only a few days prior to the Kelsleys, accompanied by his wife and five children.

Gold at Dry Creek, the Kelsley family returned to Napa Valley the next year. They were there when the revolution took place and went to live at the fort at Sonoma under Captain Merriweather.

In 1849 we went to California overland and shipped our thoughts by water. We sold our stock on our last march from which the town of Koloerville got its name, and received only \$10,000 dollars, and that was the reason why our trip to Humboldt did not turn out as predictably as we expected. We ne-

sisted in starting the town of Alameda, Arizona. In 1851 I returned to our home in Sacramento. I came through 25 miles, and my husband went through to the fort with his team and wagon, and Mexican an Indian went down on a little boat called the Sea Gull.

Starting for Mexico to buy cattle the Indians attacked. We say's camp in Tijuana, and he was killed.

"They succeeded in capturing my girl because her dress & gunpowder to the British. She was twenty years old. The other girl reported that she could hear the Indians and her nerves as they stood there."

"We all remained in camp and heard the girls' story, but did not find my girl, as she had recovered sufficiently to wander around in search of help. We found her in the hills, and an Indian was captured when he was caught in Los Angeles in February, 1852. My daughter died in Fresno when she was eighteen from the injuries she received in an accident.
