## BIGELOW HAD BIG HEAD.

#### Produced Over Confidence, Resulting in Failure.

Milwaukee, May 2 .- The first authen-Milwaukee, May 2.—The first authen-tic statement in regard to the cause of the downfall of Frank G. Bigelow, the defaulting bank president, was made today by an intimate friend of the for-mer banker. In brief, Bigelow's friend attributes the disaster to over-confi-dence in his business ability, which the banker did not possess. Bigelow, his friend states, denies emphatically that he tost the money in whest deals.

friend states, defies emphatically that he lost the money in wheat deals. "If you were to ask him how the money was spent he would be unable to tell you," said Mr. Bigelow's friend. "His affairs are in a remarkable tan-gle. To my mind there is no reason to believe that the defalcation dates back believe that the defalcation dates back more than comparatively a few years. "As to his alleged defalcation from other banks, isn't it a banker's busi-ness to see that it is secured? Look-ing at it from a purely business stand-point, it is impossible to steal from a bank if the business of the bank is safeguarded. For instance, one com-pany in St. Louis loaned Mr. Bigelow \$50,000. Bigelow gave as security stock in the First National bank worth much more. There is no reason to suppose

in the First National bank worth much more. There is no reason to suppose that he meant to defraud the St. Louis institution. There was nothing about him to indicate that he did. He paid the interest regularly, and as a matter of fact did not intend to be dishonest. He thought he was a financier. "He kept no books, and for odds and ends of all sorts he had mind only as their depositories. I am sure I don't know whether it indicates mental weakness on his part.
