## CHOLERA AND MUHAMMEDANISM.

The ravages of the cholera in the Orient and in some Mediterranean ports has again drawn the attention of the public to some religious rites peculiar to the Muhammedan world and to which it is thought much of the dread epidemic can be traced. One of our exchanges, the "Bremerton Record Union," devotes an editorial to the subject and uses some pretty strong language. It says:

If Mecca and its dirty pilgrimage, that Roman well and its water-blessing qualities are such a means to the creation of pestilence, we may as well let the Devil's own hell upon Mecca. But let us cleanse the whole region, and as the point of the hypocrite's neck those vagabond filthy rascals those hags and dogs and scoundrels of God's law be banished.

It is hardly necessary to delineate our radical measures, and yet the question is grave enough and ought to be considered by the European powers whose words are lost in the studio Paris.

Every year, in the last month of the Muhammedan year, thousands of pilgrims gather to worship in Mecca. It is true that they are a particularly filthy set. On the contrary, they compare favorably with the thousands of Christian pilgrims who flock to the Holy Land. Their religion prescribes cleanliness, to exaggeration almost, and the pilgrims, above all others, follow the precepts to the letter. Yet the crowding together of so many thousands, the absence of sanitary regulation, and the tropical heat of the country are very favorable to disease.

But the really dangerous feature of the whole matter is the custom of offering sacrifices at a grand scale. In the pilgrimage. When the last stone at Mecca has been lifted and the third is quenched by the water of the well Zamzam, in memory of Hagar wandering in the desert, the devotees go to the most holy Arabic cities as a ransom. In the valley Mina, where according to Muhammedan tradition, Abraham was about to slay Isaac, the great sacrifice takes place. Thousands of animals are gathered together. The wealthy pilgrim kill one camel or more. Some cattle are said to have slain, some three thousand of these animals. But even the poorest will sacrifice a sheep. And not only in this valley but all over the Muhammedan world the day is celebrated with sacrifices. It is the "great feast" or the Kurban Rite, the "feast of sacrifice" of the followers of the oriental prophet. The result is easily imagined. In places where the salt waves of the sea do not wash away the blood and the remains of the killed animals. The stench in a few hours becomes almost unbearable. And no wonder that the public slaughter places become the receptacles of dangerous germs that only need favorable winds to be carried over Europe and Asia.

In later years the Turkish and Egyptian governments have endeavored to prevent the danger by颁布ing sanitary rules and regulations, but these do not go far enough. The effective remedy would be the establishment of censitaries in the places where the sacrifices are slain, and we believe the sultans could easily be persuaded to take such strict and proper arguments were used. The civilized world which is threatened by the cholera has a perfect right, not to compel the Muhammedans at the point of the bayonet to cease one of their religious practices, but to surround it with such stringent laws as to make it an incensed menace to the health of the rest of mankind.

THE "DAM" SCAFFOLD.

Through the medium of the New York Sun of the 2d ult., we are introduced to one Mr. "Tom" Nuttall, a personage whom he describes as "Mr. Tom Nuttall's Evidence Lawyer and Witness Collector," and of whom the Atlanta Constitution gives these generous particulars: "Mr. Nuttall's connection with Mr. Smith's legal practice in Atlanta was of a very close and confidential nature. He had charge of the collection of evidence to Mr. Smith's large damage practice, and it was to get witness testimony and locate important evidence in the

case to which his attention was directed."

It appears that the testing and finding of Mr. Nuttall's have constituted one of the journalistic sensations of the southern city. The case quotes, and we complete the story reproduced from another Atlanta paper, thus:

"The appointment was made early in June.

We are further informed that the pay of Mr. Nuttall in his new position will be \$1,500 a year, and railroad expenses; and since it is now understood by inquiry among local officials that the gentleman is somewhere about the Uintah reservation investigating matters and things in that interesting region, we desire to record the opinion that the compensation is little enough, and the railroad expenses will not be excessive. Furthermore, we cannot join in the sarcasm levied with which the Salt Lake City papers, and with whom, incidentally, Mr. Nuttall is closely connected, regard him as a chieftain and popular as his chief, and that as an efficient lawyer and collector of witnesses in his Territory he will never himself be much longer.
