Bosten, Nov. 10,-The missionary committee of the Methodiat Episcopal convention today voted unan-mousiy to appropriate \$1,220,000 for missionary work during the coming year, and that this sum is to be divided so as to give \$.61,500 for work in the foreign field and \$516,500 for domestic work. The question of the apportio ment of the money for foreign missions among the variant countries was deterred until tomorrow. The total appropriations for home mission work today aggregated \$125,630. The parts of the countries which were given special consideration were the auting districts of Michigan, the prat-ric strips of the Transmississippi states and the mining comps of the Rockies.
