John A. Kimball Convicted.—The trial of John A. Kimball, late mail agent on the Utah and Northern Railroad, which had been in progress at Ogden for some days, was concluded on Monday night. There were two counts in the indictment; one for embezzlement and another for stealing five dollars from a letter which had been deposited in the United States Mail car for transmission to its destination. The jury returned a verdict of guilty on the second count. The Ogden *Herald* states in its account of the proceedings, that sentence was deferred till Saturday. The convicted man is a son of General Nathan Kimball, well known in this city.
