now let us see what the law of the Territory is upon this business. The latest territorial statute in relation to liquors was approved March 9, 1882. and has the following exception in tavor of vine growers :. "That no provision of this act shall be so construed as to prohibit wine growers without a license from expressing and selling on the premises where expressed, the pure fulce of the grape in quantities not less than five gallons to one person at one ime." Observe, the manufacturer of the wine, in order to be exempt from the tax authorized by the law, which covers the manufacture, sale, barter, dealing out, or other disposition of vinous as well as spirituous malt and other intoxicating liquors, must be the grower of the grapes expressed for wine making, and the product must be the pure juice of the grape, unmixed with spirit, and it must be sold on the premises where expressed, in quantierson at one time.
