A BILL
*Granting rights of way to railroad
companies in the several
Territories.*

[This bill passed the House Jan. 27, 1873.]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That in the several Territories the right of way across the public lands, not exceeding two hundred feet in width, and
