LOCAL AND OTHER MATTERS.

THE STORM.—Last night the minarels had a much better house than could have been expected considering the intensity of the storm. As usual, everything was good, and Richard III in Dutch was huge. We are pleased to notice that this business is again announced for this evening. Tomorrow evening a complimentary benefit to Messrs. Murphy & Mack is announced by the Management, and on Saturday afternoon a minarels for families and children. The minarels make their last appearance in this city on Saturday evening.

GR. FRANCIS TRAIN.—The irrefragable, erratic and unique G. F. T. is announced to deliver one or more of his sensational lectures at our Theatre very shortly. They will be something entirely out of the common to most of our citizens.

THE STORM.—About sunset last evening a storm of almost unprecedented severity, during the short time it lasted, burst over this city. The wind, for a few moments, blew a hurricane, followed by drenching showers of rain, and most vivid lightning and loud thunder. Shortly after nine the weather cleared up, but occasional showers fell during the night. In the northern sections, we learn through dispatches by the Democrat Telegraph line from Logan, Brigham City and Ogden, that the thunder and lightning were very severe, though but little rain fell. We have not been able to discover the extent of the storm south of this city owing to the telegraph line being down in the neighborhood of Payson.

DANGEROUS PASTIMES.—We can always be counted amongst those who are pleased to see our youth enjoying themselves; but, as a wise man of old observed, there is a time for all things, so we consider there is a place for all things, and that the principal business streets of our city, no matter how dull trade may be, is not the place for boys to fly kites, play at ball, or other games. These recreations were brought to our mind by seeing this morning a kite drop down in the middle of East Temple street, immediately in front of a spirited horse, attached to a carriage in which were several persons. Had not the horse been in the hands of a skillful driver, considerable damage might have been done through the kite falling so near its face. We have heard of many serious accidents occurring to life and property from this cause. There is plenty of room in and around our city, for boys to fly their kites, without intruding on the business quarter, and a few words of kindly admonition from those interested in the young folks may prove a preventive of serious accidents.

SECURE BREADSTUFFS.—Wheat, flour, and products of every kind are now offered for sale at remarkably low prices in this city. The contrast between the price which rules now and that which was paid for these articles a few months ago is very striking. There are various causes for this, but all more or less within the control of those who offer these products for sale. We doubt not that many, who are now anxious to sell breadstuffs at the present reduced prices, will be equally anxious, before another harvest, to buy the same articles at greatly enhanced figures. We hope this may not be the case, but we think it will. Every man should have at least one year's supply, and two years, or even more, if he can get it. Better to go short of some other articles than neglect the present favorable opportunity of securing the staff of life. A family can do without money, they can get along with a reduced stock of clothing; but they cannot live without food. Let the past experience on this point suffice, and let no one be so foolish as to think because wheat and flour are now cheap, that, therefore, they are poor pay. Take all you can get.

UNRIPED FRUIT.—We hear that sickness begins to manifest itself among children in the city. This month and next are, as a rule, the most trying months of the year for children in this country. They require constant watchfulness and care. Better for mothers to neglect other duties than to fail on these points just now. We are confident that much sickness may be avoided, and valuable lives be saved, by mothers exercising vigilance and judiciously nursing their children and watching their symptoms. But special care should be taken not to suffer them to eat unripe fruit. We have known of several children being attacked by severe sickness, and in some cases dying, through the neglect of this precaution. If they can get hold of trashy melons, they devour them greedily, then nothing can so nearly be more hurtful. We seriously question the propriety of permitting them to eat fruit of any kind during this month and next; but if they do, it should be good, wholesome fruit, and be eaten sparingly.

GETTING READY.—The California folks are troubled about the coming of another earthquake, one of their savants having predicted that it is now at their doors. The San Francisco Times thus refers to the prediction: "The author thinks the electrical signs and symptoms are favorable, and desires people generally to place their chimneys and fire-works on an earthquake footing. He thinks the quake will come off early in the Autumn, as soon as moist clouds float into the dry, vaporous atmosphere. Since the article was written, the singular red lights have made their appearance in the heavens. Mr. Stewart has written another article, in which he says, if those manifestations in the sky were electrical, and we have equalized the electrical condition of the earth, and thus have decreased the danger of the earthquake."

TOOLEE CITY.—Our cor respondent Nestor, under date of 23d inst., writes us very encouragingly of the state of affairs in Toolee. He says, "Last Friday the 20th inst., the Graniteville Woolen Factory Co., previous to setting up their machinery, extended an invitation to the people of Toolee County to participate in a social gathering, at their mill, the dance was kept up till some wee sma' hour ayont the wall." The wheat crop in this part is excellent, and the other crops would have been very good, had not the iron clouds taken such a fancy to them. Our set of breeches, made by the firm of Benson & Co., of London, has arrived in good condition. Our band has been organized under the leadership of Capt. Thos. Croft, late band leader of the Volunteer Rifle Corps of Woodford, Essex, England, and we are proud in having so experienced an instructor in the science of music, as Toolee does not wish to be behind its neighbors in any good thing. The storm of last Thursday evening was very severe here. It lasted three hours, and ended, I am pleased to say, with no serious result, except a drenching to those who live under poor roofs."
