The telephone business in Ohio is done by local companies, who lease instruments from the pa-rent companies; there is no general or managing agent of the parent company in Ohio. As to the claim on the gov-ernment that the dealing in a patent made the company domestic in the en-tire territory of the United States co-existent with the patent, the court held that it could not be sustained. The grant to the patentee is a right to ex-clude others from making or selling his patent. His right to sell is only a common law right and is not a franchise from the government.
