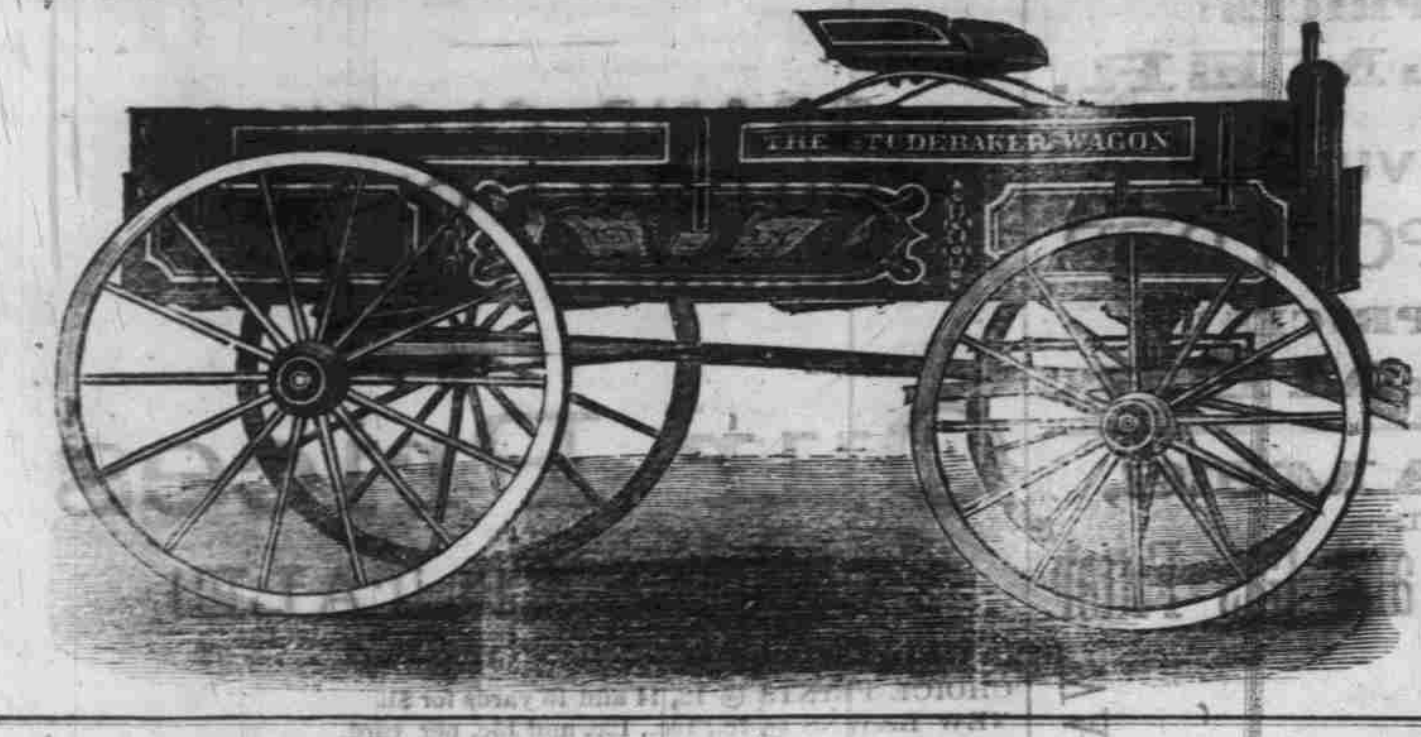

## EVENING NEWS.

Monday, August 22, 1881.

### SUNDAY SERVICES.

The usual services of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints were held in the Tabernacle Sunday, August 21, 1881, at 2 p. m. The choir sang an opening hymn: Awake, ye Saints of God, awake! Prayer by Elder Edward Snellgrove. The choir sang the sacramental hymn: Hail, the Great Redeemer dead.

Elder Henry W. Nalsbitt addressed the congregation. He referred to the tendency of the age to take the shortest ways to the summit of success, and he pointed out the remarkable among the American people, whose national characteristic was rapidly of progress in every direction. This tendency had its advantages, but it also had its dangers. The man who rose suddenly to eminence, who was educated rapidly or acquired wealth with ease and speed, was less likely to retain it, than one who by slower, surer methods, accomplished his desires. This principle applied in theology as in all else. God is a being who works by gradual processes. He did not expect to reap where He had not sown, nor to attain results for which He had not labored. Such was Christ, an earnest, faithful laborer, humbly striving to carry out the will of His Father and to do the works which He had seen His Father do. And thus He, the Son of God, had been crucified for the benefit of mankind. Christ chose His disciples from the meek and lowly of the earth, and when they went forth to preach the gospel they exhibited the characteristics of industry, patience and persistence. They did not preach that faith was all-sufficient for salvation, but that men must work out their salvation, and secure it by a union of faith with works. They believed that all who were rewarded according to their works, and they preached and taught accordingly. Christ believes to-day that faith is the all-essential principle of salvation, but the Latter-day Saints hold the belief which was entertained by the ancient Saints, that works are also absolutely necessary, and that the system which inculcates this doctrine is nearest to divine. They have exemplified their faith by their works, and they have been rewarded accordingly. They have been believers in the divinity of labor, and their Apostles have been the Apostles of labor. They believe in the same way that is given ample evidence, and they recognize no royal road to learning. The idea held by the Latter-day Saints respecting the development of character, transcends that of any other people on earth. They believe they are the children of God, created with faculties which if perfected will elevate them to the exaltation of their Father, and they realize that the only way to this exaltation is by the faithful advancement cannot be accomplished except by a continued labor; by studying and practicing the methods through which their Father was raised to the high position He occupies. The speaker touched upon the first principles of the Gospel, showing the first steps necessary in the accomplishment of a work, and also showed how further advancement was to be made toward perfection. God had made work sublime, and had decreed that there should be no progress without it.

President George Q. Cannon was the next speaker.
