

VERDICT OF THE WAR COMMISSION

Alger and Family Had No Interest
in Any Contracts.

WILL FIX RESPONSIBILITY.

President McKinley Will Place the
Blame Wherever it Deserves in Each of
the Departments.

Chicago, Jan. 26.—A Washington dispatch to the New York Herald, which was received here this morning, says: President McKinley will have in his possession on Thursday next a complete report of the war investigating commission. The report will comprise about 800 words. Attached to it will be an appendix of 200 printed pages, setting forth all of the testimony taken by the commission during its investigation.

In fact, the next three days will be most important for Secretary Alger as the commission is finally to determine just what facts shall be presented to show the inefficiency in the administration of the war department. Details of the report can be given. It has been determined by the commission not to mention any name, but simply to record under the head of each department, and such camp, the names of individuals who were responsible, but identification will be ample so that the President will be able to fix the responsibility. Here is a summary of the main points in the verdict:

MILES ON HIS DIGNITY.

The secretary of war intended the major general commanding to make an inspection tour of camps. The major general commanding returned the order to the adjutant general that he was not in a position to make out his own orders.

The major general commanding was succeeded by the major general commanding, who carried on the inspection, and at the same time the secretary of war informed Gen. Shafter that Miles was not to be superseded him in command.

A large number of civilians who were without experience were appointed to staff positions, but they quickly learned their duties.

ALGER VINDICATED.

The secretary performed against the secretary of war that he and members of his family were interested in sites selected for camps and in contracts awarded to contractors. The major general commanding recommended locations of camps at Chickamauga and Tammie and an officer on the staff of Miles. Miles was succeeded by Gen. Shafter. The secretary strongly opposed the location of camps at Miami.

The majority of men did not know of the condition of the troops when they came to Miami, until the "Round Robin" was circulated, when steps were taken to bring troops north.

NOT ENOUGH INSPECTIONS.

A sufficient number of inspections was not made by the inspector general, and it has been shown that the camp conditions would not have been as serious as they proved to be, had more frequent and more thorough inspections been made.

Most of the officers of the inspector general's department were transferred to valuable service and placed in command of troops. In the plan of the inspection corps being taken by the inspector general in inspection work, will be evidence of typical and typical conduct of the inspector general. Inspections have been instituted, but not observed.

The committee will show that this department should be disbanded.

No irregularities have been found in the quartermaster general's department, notwithstanding many charges previously made. The quartermaster general, and his assistants, were found to be perfectly dressed. In the matter of horses, it was shown that the quartermaster general had not been paid for supplies taken care of between \$100 and \$200, as cheap as any manufacturer in the country could have furnished them.

It will be found that in no case were prices paid were cheaper than those paid for the same articles elsewhere.

CHASER KEEPS HIS ATTENTION.

The administration of the commissioners will be held over, and the commissioners will be called to disbursements amounting to about \$10,000, and the statement will be made that the government obtained full value.

BEEF SCANDAL.

Investigating the beef controversy, the commissioners who did the charges that cattle were used to preserve beef are without exception exonerated. They are exonerated, however, because they furnished the army meat in quality and sufficient quantity. Attention will be called to the fact that the meat which the cattle were used was placed on a transport at Tampa by Mr. Powell, and did not belong to the government.

With regard to canned beef, the commissioners will find that meat was preserved by the use of salt, and that in the hot climate of Cuba the meat melted and gave an unwholesome appearance to the contents of the cans. The meat was entirely palatable and nutritious.

There will be laid upon the failure of the commissioners commanding to tell the public of the condition of war to the character of beef and meat used when Mr. Daly first reported to the commissioners, and the fact that they did not let the public know of the attention of the commissioners to the discovery was made.

THE DAILY TURNED DOWN.

The report will find in Daly's statement that the commissioners will indicate that it does not concur in these. A sufficient number of inspections were made by the inspector general's department. Proper sanitary regula-

tions were not strictly enforced. There was error in some instances in furnishing meat to the army.

The pay department was administered satisfactorily. Gen. Miles' statement that had the troops in Florida been supplied with meat, they would have been able to purchase supplies is not borne out by the paymaster's report. The paymaster's report shows that the Porto Rican army, which was captured without injury, had no fault with any of the other departments.

CAMPAGNA VERDICTS.

Gen. Shafter's admission of mistakes will be tested. With respect to the Porto Rican campaign, it will be seen that the rough riders did not fall into ambuscades at La Guanica, but that the Indians had been selected as a sample group.

The report will say there was no such mistake in Cuba, and the claim that the Indians were responsible will be shown that the Porto Rican campaign was a success.

With respect to Montana Potts, the commissioners will say that the war department had no idea of the condition of the Indians in the state.

The report will say there was a great deal of enthusiasm owing to the camping there of two regiments and a large number of Indians from San Juan. Only 23 deaths are registered there, three are registered on transports.
