

SCHOOL BOARD MEETING.

The Janitors' Salary List Received.—Employment of Teachers.—Miscellanous.

The city school board met last night all members being present except Dooly. Following is the business transacted:

Mrs. Susie Root, Grace E. Lee and Lettie Leavenworth applied for positions as teachers. Referred.

Johannes Halverson sent in a communication relative to the selling of real estate in Superior addition to the house, stating that a water contract would go with the lots and that he would reduce the price from \$2000 to \$1500. Referred.

The committee on sites and buildings reported that they had rented an additional room in the Third ward from Peter Simler, for five months from February 10th to July 10th, for the total sum of \$125, the board to be at the expense of removing the partitions and placing the building in proper condition. The owner is to replace the same at the expiration of the lease. It is also satisfactory to have his premises adjacent to the rooms rented by the board. Accepted.

The committee on furniture and supplies recommended that the janitors' rolls be revised as follows:

Janitors of twelve room buildings to be paid at the rate of \$1000 per year for twelve months.

All eight room buildings except the Bryant, at the rate of \$800 per year for twelve months.

The janitor of the Bryant school to be paid at the rate of \$700 per year for twelve months, to begin with the building of the new school completed, and to include running the same. The janitor is furnished with house and food and lights.

The janitor's salary of the Seventh school was increased from \$45 to \$50 per month, beginning March 1st, and to be paid for twelve months.

The janitor's salary of the Fourteenth school to be decreased from \$50 per month to \$40 per month, said salary to run for twelve months.

Wherever changes affect present institutions, the new rates to apply from and after March 1st, 1893.

The committee on finance having examined into the matter, the notice in behalf of the Salt Lake City Board of Education reported that they had issued to the contractors and bidders a warrant to never issue ten to date, the present one being for \$4,000, the bondsmen of Mr. Wright being with the board and the contractors in the sum of \$40,000, leaving judgment that might be rendered against the board. The committee further reported that they had examined the statements of the treasurer and found that they agreed with the books of the church.

Pattison moved that the committee on sites and buildings be instructed to meet up the southeast and northwest basement rooms of the Franklin school, and that the contractor be allowed to use them in Hamilton school for use as school rooms, if their judgment said rooms are proper for school purposes. Carried.

A resolution by Young was adopted which provided for the appropriation of \$1000 to the maintenance of the Lowell school building.
