Park City Fire.

ABOUT 11 o'clock last night a fire broke out in L. C. Osborne's furniture store at Park City, and soon effected the destruction of the building and its contents. The building was owned by Boyle & Co. of Ogden, and was valued at \$2000. Osborne's stock was valued at \$1000, on which there is no insurance. The cause of the fire is unknown. The fire department, by prompt action, prevented the spread of damage to neighboring structures.

Quarters for City Officials.

The City Council committee, to whom was referred the question of securing office rooms for heads of departments and other city employees, met yesterday morning and appointed a portion of the Brigham Young Trust Company's handsome building on Commercial street, for that purpose.

Joint Business Block.

Bids will be submitted tomorrow for the erection of a three-story brick block with basement, by the Brigham Young Trust Company and Henry Dinwoodey, on Pine Street, between Main and West Temple streets. The building will be a joint affair, with the Brigham Young Trust Company occupying the first floor, Henry Dinwoodey the second, and the rest of the building will be let to various business concerns. The estimated cost is between \$150,000 and \$200,000. When work commences the building will be put up to a rapid completion.

Electric Light Addition.

Tudor and Brain, the well known contractors, will within a day or two commence the erection of a third addition to the Electric Light company's works. It will be placed upon machinery for increasing the capacity of light service.

A UNIQUE TABLE.

It was made of Mahogany, Cedar, Oak and Silver, at the instance of Lehi Ladies.

There was on exhibition in a show window of S. E. Tessell's store on Main street a very unique piece of furniture in the shape of a center table. The support was of beautifully grained native mountain mahogany, the corners of Cedar cedar, and the varnish or epoxy taken from Pellow Point. The white was obtained from the best white marble from the Utah mine at Fish Springs and reduced to the Germania.

The table was made at the instance of the ladies of Lehi, who are connected with the World's Fair, and a good addition to the Electric Light company's works. It will be forwarded to Chicago to be placed on exhibition at the Columbian Exposition.

JOINT SESSION.

The City Council and County Court Wrestling with the Fireproof Proposition.

A PROMINENT NOTE TROUBLE.

Ella Whisner and her Sister Win the Suit Against Simon Brothers.

Parley E. Williams, attorney for the board of education, argued a motion before Judge Hale this morning, that the garnishment served on the board by Simon & Co. be set aside.

Simon & Co. furnished material for the building of the Elementar school and sold to W. H. Jay the materials and some time ago Jay abandoned paying the bill in an undivided interest. Staff was instituted against Jay and a judgment for \$2,200 was rendered against him on November 13 in the Third District Court, and a garnishment was served on the board to catch any funds that might be owing to Jay on his contract, so far the board has not taken any official action in the matter.

Judge Hale appeared for Mason and Company and he felt that it would not be good policy to set aside the garnishment for various reasons which he gave.

After the argument had been concluded, Judge Hale took the papers and will probably render a decision tomorrow morning.

A PROHIBITION NOTE CASE.

The case of Palmer & Hoy, vs. James Wallis and Higgins & McLean, was argued before Judge Hale this morning. It was the first hearing of the case, and an injunction of \$2,500 was issued to do as principal defendant, etc., on a promissory note. The note was signed by James Wallis and his son, John, and the manager of the Prohibition machine as well—say, so insufficient that I think I shall do so."
