TOOK HIS OWN LIFE

Loring H. Brown Shoots Himself
Through the Head.Had the Idea That His Life Was
Nigh at His Hands—A Victim
of Suicide.

Loring H. Brown, who has been employed at the office of the Utah State Engineer, at 151 East Temple street, committed suicide at 11 o'clock last night by shooting with a Winchester rifle.

From appearances Brown must have stood upon a chair and leaned over on the gun, which was discharged with his left hand. His right hand was raised to his forehead, and in his breast was the hole made by the bullet, and death was doubtless instantaneous.

Brown lived with his widowed mother in a cottage on Third street, just over the Jordan river. For some time his health has been poor and yesterday he went home, saying he was ill to work longer. On reaching home he appeared gloomy and told his mother that a number of persons would kill him if they caught him. He made her understand that he was determined to kill himself, and during the evening he continually kept water from the windows for the supposed enemies. He was finally induced to retire and Mrs. Brown then retired in an adjoining room. At 11 o'clock the door was unlocked by the mother and a gasp, then a lighted lamp and a scream were the only sounds that came from the room.

The mother found her son lying on the floor, his head resting on the wall, and his hands clasped over his forehead. He was still breathing, but his eyes were closed. The mother called for help, and the neighbors and police were notified by telephone. The mother felt very badly and could not be persuaded to leave the side of her boy, saying: "He's the only boy I had, and now he's gone."

Justice Hammer arrived soon after midnight and so inquired was held, and the following verdict rendered: "The said L. H. Brown came to his death by shooting himself with a Winchester rifle, and he was sane at the time he committed the act."

The jury was F. A. Cary, M. R. Lowry and D. L. DeWitt. Mr. Brown and Mrs. Collins were the only witnesses.

Brown was 35 years of age and unmarried. He came from Riverside, Cal., with his mother some two years ago.

Brown was said by some to be of a morose disposition. When the outside of Frank Williams, that was, was talked about he was the only one who failed to join in the conversation.

WORKINGMEN MEET.

Speeches by Warren Power and H. W. Lawrence.

Lawrence—(To the) to the Legislature.

The meeting of the unemployed held in the old Federal court room last night was well attended. Mr. Bullis presided and T. C. Bailey acted as secretary. Warren Power and H. W. Lawrence were the principal speakers.

Mr. Power spoke of the cause leading up to the present condition of work and the cause and effect of poverty and depression. Mr. Lawrence spoke on the condition of the working man, and advocated the government ownership of railways, the control by the people of industries that employ labor and the wiping out of the taxation on a working man's home and his tools used for earning his living.

Several petitions were presented and read. One was to the Legislature asking that household goods and articles be made free from taxation, and that the tax on the land be abolished. Another to the Legislature asking that contract labor in all state and municipal work be done away with. Two other petitions were to the City Council and county court, calling attention to the fact that the unemployed workers in Salt Lake were out of employment and ask that they be given work.

It was decided that the petitions be presented to the Legislature by Mr. Thompson.

LOOKED INTO THE FIRE.

A chamberman's room of the fire and police board was held last evening at which time the management of and work done at the Hotel-Amerasia fire was investigated. These examiners were H. W. Whittemore, the insurance man, Officer Louis Joseph O'Leary of the George St. South company, Superintendent Wallace of the waterworks department and Police Sergeant Frank White.

Commissioner Dillingham acted as recorder and put the witness through a series of questions touching on the promptness of the department in responding, the work done after arriving and the manner in which the fire was managed by Chief Devine. The meeting adjourned without any further action being taken.
