FAVOR THE PLAINTIFF. Manufacturers of Pink Pills Win Pre-

liminary Skirmish in Libel Ac-tion Against Collier's.

Van Kirk, of the Supreme Court of the Van Kirk, of the Supreme Court of the State of New York, has handed down two decisions on preliminary motions in the action for \$160,060 damages for malicious libel, brought by the manu-facturers of Dr. Williams' Pink Pilis against Collier's Weekly. Both deci-sions are in favor of the medicine com-pany. The court holds with the plain-tiff that certain portions of the answer of the defendant are irrelevant and re-dundant and grants a motion to strike of the defendant are irrelevant and re-dundant and grants a motion to strike them out. A motion by the attorneys for Collier's requiring the medicine company to furnish the defendants with the formula of its medical preparation is denied. In the opinion handed down, Justice Van Kirk says, "the ingredients that make up this compound are not at issue in the case.
