CAPTAIN A. O. SMOOT'S COMPANY.

15 Miles west Fort Kearney, }
May 29, 1856. }

EDITOR DESERET NEWS:

Since leaving Laramie we have made fair progress, and the camp has enjoyed the best of health.

At the crossing of the South Fork we met the first Californian emigration, and since then we have passed trains almost hourly. Yesterday we met about 2000 head of cattle, and every company has a large herd. We have also passed several government trains freighted with corn for General Harney's command.

We have seen no buffalos on the road, and have killed but very little game of any kind. From appearances the emigration on the north side of the Platte far exceeds that on the south.

We have not seen any Indians since we left the vicinity of Fort Laramie.

May 30.—We have found the road to-day literally filled with emigrant trains, so much so as to crowd us much of the time out of the track. The rumor is that the Mormon emigration is tremendous; 5000 are said to be fitting up at Omaha city, and as many more at other points.

VIOLENT HAIL STORM IN VIRGINIA.—One of the most violent hail storms that ever occurred in Virginia, swept over the county of Lunenburg to Amelia Court House, yesterday. In the woods and some other places it lay upon the ground to the depth of four inches, some of the hailstones being of large size. Leaves were stripped from the trees and fences blown down, but we have heard of no other damage.—[Richmond Whig, May 3.]

AN ACT granting unto John Stoker, William Smith, John W. Hess and Abiah Wardsworth, the north end of Weber valley for a Herd Ground and other purposes.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Governor and Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Utah: That that portion of Weber valley, in the Territory of Utah, bounded on the south by the north line of the legislative grant given to Thomas J. Thurston, Jedediah M. Grant and George W. Thurston; on the west by the summit of the mountains skirting said valley on the west; on the north by the summit of the mountains bounding said valley on the north; and on the east by the summit of the mountains skirting said valley on the east; be, and the same is hereby granted unto John Stoker, William Smith, John W. Hess and Abiah Wardsworth, for a herd ground and other purposes.

Sec. 2. The said John Stoker, William Smith, John W. Hess and Abiah Wardsworth, shall have the exclusive control of said grant, during the pleasure of the Legislative Assembly.

AN ACT granting unto Thomas J. Thurston, Jedediah M. Grant and George W. Thurston, the south end of Weber valley for a Herd Ground and other purposes.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Governor and Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Utah: That all that portion of Weber valley, in the Territory of Utah, bounded on the north by a line commencing at the summit of the mountains skirting said valley on the west, and running due east crossing Weber river one mile below the junction of East Canyon creek with said river, and terminating at the summit of the mountains bounding said valley on the east; thence along the summit of the mountains south south-west, west, and north to the place of beginning, be, and the same is hereby granted unto Thomas J. Thurston, Jedediah M. Grant, and George W. Thurston, for a herd ground and other purposes.

Sec. 2. The said Thomas J. Thurston, Jedediah M. Grant and George W. Thurston, shall have the exclusive use and control of said grant, together with all the products and benefits arising therefrom, during the pleasure of the Legislative Assembly.
