

INCOME TAX AMENDMENT

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By Vote of 317 to 14 House **Passes Senate Joint** Resolution.

DEMOCRATS VOTED FOR IT.

Washington, July 12 .- By the decisive vote of 317 to 14, more than the necessary two-thirds, the house today passed the senate joint resolution providing for the submission of the income tax question to the states. The negative votes were all cast by Republicans. The res-

olution now goese to the president for his signature. The debate lasted about four hours. Chairman Payne, of the committee on ways and means voiced the sentiment that such a tax would make "a nation of liars.'
