### HARD TO COLLECT RENTS.

State Land Board Has Difficulty in Leasing Under New Rule.

The report of the state board of land commissioners for the fiscal year ending Nov. 30, 1905, has been filed with Gov. Cutler by Secretary John De Gray Dixon. During the year the board held 24 meetings. Of the \$24,000 appropriated for the expenses of the board the sum of \$9,382 was expended during the year. The report states that the leasing of state lands is very unsatisfactory, as it is very difficult to collect the rents. The board now requires cash deposits in advance, hence there has been a decrease in the number of leases during the year.

The government project in the Strawberry valley is mentioned in the report, which states that the project means the expenditure of from \$800,000 to \$1,000,000, and the redemption of 50,000 acres of land in Utah and adjacent counties. To the action of the government in settling aside large tracts of land for forest reserves is attributed the decrease in the selection of state lands during the year. The uniform charges for state lands is now fixed at \$2.50 per acre. The total appraisement of state lands at the close of the report was \$99,954.54 of the value of \$2,094,875.12, with improvements valued at \$181,621.61.

There were 29,320.26 acres leased during the year, for \$2,101.41. Total selections for the year amounted to 91,852.09 acres. Of these selections for 14,512 acres were approved. Lands aggregating 66,735.04 acres were offered in public auction in Cache, Weber and Utah counties. During the year 42,011.39 acres were sold for \$75,746.82. Sales covering 33,619 acres, worth \$58,548.80, were cancelled during the year. Unsold land Nov. 30, 1905, amounted to 1,859,621.11 acres. Of these, 353,495 acres are unappraised, 133,919.79 acres are appraised, and not offered, 1,452,217.32 acres are offered for sale.

## PROPERTY GOES TO THE CHURCH.

Case of Mrs. Helen Watson Finally Disposed of by the Supreme Court.

### DEED PROPERLY EXECUTED.

Court Holds That Mr. Chatfield Knew What He Was Doing When He Drew It Up.

By the opinion of the supreme court, handed down Saturday afternoon and mentioned in the Saturday "News," the title of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to the north half of lot 4, block 61, plat A, Salt Lake City survey, has been confirmed. Mrs. Helen Watson was the defendant in the case and attempted to have the deed to the property executed by her stepfather, George Chatfield, declared null and void on the ground that he was not of sound and disposing mind when he executed the deed to the church.

From the evidence it appeared that Chatfield executed the deed on the day before his death and he gave his wife a life interest in it and upon her death it should go to the church. Mrs. Watson was the only heir to her mother's estate and she claimed title to the property and endeavored to prove that her stepfather did not know what he was doing when he deeded the property to the church. The lower court on the first trial of the case found in favor of plaintiff. Upon appeal the supreme court granted a new trial. On the second trial the case was again decided in favor of plaintiff and another appeal was taken and again a new trial was granted. The third trial resulted the same as the other two and defendant again appealed. The supreme court now affirms the judgment of the lower court on the third appeal, hence the case is ended. The opinion of the court was written by Justice McCarthy and concurred in by Chief Justice Barlow and Justice Crump.

### REVIVAL MEETINGS.

Rev. Coburn Speaks on the New Birth and Other Subjects.

The East Side Baptists continue their revival meetings, and in his sermon yesterday morning, Rev. Dr. Coburn preached on the new birth and the new life. He said: "The new birth stands at the beginning of the regenerate life. It is the work not of flesh, but of the spirit. Man's sinfulness is the cause of his need of the new birth. The power of hereditary operating. The reproduction here of the wishes and desires of the Christ. The burden for souls, the longing of the higher life."

At 4 p. m. Dr. Coburn spoke on the overflow of God's love in the heart, explaining how the natural heart is pictured by the stone. As long as it is in the way the life cannot be filled with love divine. When this is away the life must be emptied of sin, then God's blessings are poured in. When the heart is full and overflows, others are blessed.

At the evening service the subject was "Will Thou Be Made Whole?" He said: "Jesus Christ comes when we are in our need, in our helplessness, to ask a question of the greatest importance. That question is, 'Will thou be made whole?' We are doing tonight just what we will. The future is a matter of our own choosing. This is a personal question. Jesus said 'thou.' He is a personal God as ever. He singles men out and calls us by name. This question speaks of an outside power able to do His work. Will thou be made whole? Is able to save the devil's castaways. Man goes not so far away but Jesus is able to make whole. Come to Him as you are, it matters not what you have in your life. He is able and willing to make whole."

The meetings continue this week, Monday meetings each day at Y. M. C. A., 2-3 o'clock; Tuesday meetings each day at East Side Baptist church each day at 3:30; evening meetings each day except Monday at 7:45 at East Side Baptist church. At the service tomorrow night a stereo-optional will be used.

### USED TO TEACH HERE.

Hon. Bartlett Tripp Pays a Visit to His Old Home.

Hon. Bartlett Tripp, formerly United States minister to Austria-Hungary, arrived in Salt Lake yesterday on route to Los Angeles, after an absence from this city of 40 years. Mr. Tripp came here from Maine, in 1861, at the age of 15, and took charge of a school in the Fourteenth ward meetings house. Some 50 children resided with Mr. Tripp, among whom were ex-Gov. Wells, Hon. John Henry Smith, the northern of Idaho, Adams, Parley L. Cannon, and others. In the spring of 1862, Mr. Tripp went to California where he worked in the engineering staff of the Southern Pacific road, but returned to Utah in 1863. He then returned to the Fourteenth ward meetings house, where he continued to teach as before, and called attention to the fact that his was the first public school opened in the territory. Mr. Tripp now lives in South Dakota, and was the last chief justice in the Dakota territory. He is now in the government on the Samson Islands, and at Vienna, from 1886 to 1887. Mrs. Tripp accompanied him on his trip, and they are stopping at the Knutsford where Mr. Tripp has met with many old friends who are very glad to see him.

### FREIGHT TRAINS COLLIDE.

Traffic Suspended and Two Men Quite Badly Hurt.

Rio Grande Western traffic was completely laid out yesterday owing to a head freight wreck which occurred at a point about one mile east of Thistle yesterday morning. It was the old story of a cold morning and no flagman out to protect a train standing on a siding. The two freights were westbound and were traveling 19 minutes apart. The first train took the siding to allow the special carrying the western classification committee to pass. Hardly had the train left the main line when the wreck occurred. The Rio Grande freight, No. 45, known as the Ogden Highball, came round the curve and smashed into the rear end of the C. & N. freight, No. 10, known as the Wagoner freight. Salt Lake, and James Wagoner freight, Salt Lake, who were sleeping in the caboose, while the freight, No. 10, was being run, were badly hurt. The caboose was split into kindling wood and how both men escaped death is a mystery. The farmers, who were thrown 30 feet clear of the wreck, in all 12 cars were derailed and smashed so badly that it was necessary to burn the lot of debris in order to get the track clear for the waiting trains on either side of the wreck.

It is hoped by the trainmen that Hood No. 162, an engine that has been in a number of wrecks, will now be condemned to the scrap pile. The wreck was a costly one as it had traffic out for nine hours, and demolished things generally. Wrecking crews were summoned from Salt Lake and Tucker.

### OGDEN VALLEY RESERVOIR.

What Col. Young Said About It in an Engineering Lecture.

At the last regular meeting of the engineering society of the University, Col. Willard Young lectured on the Ogden valley reservoir to be constructed by the Utah Light and Power Co. Col. Young said in part:

"The building of the reservoir was given up on account of the expense of constructing the dam in the canyon; but since the company needs such a plant in order to duplicate the power from the other plants, the dam will be built. It will be situated about eight miles up the canyon, and when completed, 27,000 acre-feet of water can be stored. The reservoir itself will cover about 2,500 acres. The supply of water from the Ogden river will be increased about twice during the high water season and about four times during the low water season. The farmers, who have a right to the water and can use their amount at any season of the year, on account of the safety of the people below, the directors favor an earthen dam with a masonry core."

### WILL BE SURVEYED.

Register Hobbs Grants Application To Governor Cutler.

Register Frank D. Hobbs of the Salt Lake land office issued a notice granting an application by Gov. John C. Cutler, on behalf of the state, asking for the survey of the unsurveyed portions of 13 townships lying southwest of Salt Lake. Commissioners W. A. Richards of the general land office has directed that the land described be withdrawn from entry, effect Nov. 25, 1905, and to remain unavailable for entry from the filing of the official plats in the land office. During the 60 days the state land board will select what land it desires for the state out of the territory surveyed.

The land is described as follows, the description being with reference to the Salt Lake meridian in each instance: Township 1 south, range 7 west; township 1 south, range 8 west; township 2 south, range 8 west; township 2 south, range 9 west; township 3 south, range 9 west; township 3 south, range 10 west; township 4 south, range 10 west; township 4 south, range 11 west; township 5 south, range 11 west; township 5 south, range 12 west; township 6 south, range 12 west; township 6 south, range 13 west; township 7 south, range 13 west; township 7 south, range 14 west; township 8 south, range 14 west; township 8 south, range 15 west.
