WASHINGTON, Feb. 19. The House, after the adjournment of the Senate, passed the bill for the relief of the Oregon voters, which was reported by the committee on the subject of the Oregon election.

Associated News and Robbed.

Wagon Again Before the House Committee.

WASHINGTON, 19.—The committee on the powers and privileges of the House met this afternoon, and discussed the bill for the relief of the Oregon voters, which was reported by the committee on the subject of the Oregon election.

CHICAGO, 19.—A combination of the distillers of the entire country, embracing nearly every important establishment in the United States, has been formed for the purpose of opposing the bill for the relief of the Oregon voters.

THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS.

The House committee on appropriations, to-day, completed the survey of the appropriation bill and will report it to the House at the earliest opportunity. Its principal items are, for expenses of the United States courts, including marshals, attorneys, witnesses, etc., \$2,500,000; for the support of disabled volunteer soldiers \$800,000; for signal service \$300,000; for coast survey, about \$400,000; for surveys of the Mississippi river \$100,000; for surveying public lands and private land claims \$50,000; for preservation of public buildings throughout the country \$100,000; for the payment of claims on government mail contractors for services rendered before the war \$300,000; for Haytian explorations west of the hundredth meridian \$50,000; for the Wheeler explorations, west of the hundredth meridian \$20,000; for continuing the work at Chicago buildings as follows: at Chicago and St. Louis \$400,000 each; at Philadelphia and Cincinnati \$250,000 each. The total of the bill is about \$14,000,000.

THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS.

About 100 members were present at the democratic caucus, to-night, at the Capitol, Clymer presiding. Vance, of Ohio, offered a resolution similar to that of Representative Williams at Saturday night's caucus, asserting that the democratic means to defeat the acts of the commission. This resolution caused much discussion, but was not voted on.
