

BRIEF TELEGRAMS.

Sara Bernhardt and party sailed for France yesterday.

The Duke of Avilla and Baloma, Portugal, counselor of state, is dead.

Dr. John Ruth, celebrated rifle shot, died on the 3d inst, at Oakland.

A freight train on the Texas Pacific went through a bridge, killing two and wounding two.

A fire in E. & F. King's brick building, 409 and 413 Atlantic Avenue, Boston, caused damage of about \$30,000.

The mayor of New York has ordered an immediate investigation of the books and accounts of the dock department.

The results of the Spanish municipal elections, as far as known, are favorable to the supporters of the ministry.

The volume of business last week was larger than ever before in every city in the county, with exception of Milwaukee.

Edward Ryan is arrested at Webster, Mass., for poisoning Mrs. Ryan last year. Arsenic was found in her stomach.

The Stockton gang of desperadoes have left Colorado to avoid arrest on a requisition from the governor of New Mexico.

Leonard's boiler and engine works at London, Ont., burned; loss \$60,000; insurance \$15,000. Seventy men are out of employment.

Ah Sam, a Chinaman, who was stabbed in Spring Street, New York, by a young ruffian on April 24th, died in St. Vincent's hospital.

Foul play caused the accident to the passenger train at Eagle Bridge, N. Y., yesterday. Two men recently discharged will be arrested.

Minister Lowell presided at a dinner of the Literary Fund, in London, on Wednesday night. One hundred and fifty guests were present.

A person has been arrested for posting revolutionary proclamations appealing to workmen in the Kremenchug (Poltava) railway workshops.

George Brooks and Scott Love fought a duel at Arbiston, Ohio, yesterday. Both were mortally wounded. The sheriff arrested both parties.

A fire in Shirk's tobacco warehouse, Lancaster, Pa., damaged 100 cases belonging to Esberg, Bachmann & Co., San Francisco; loss \$30,000.

In another wreck at Katula, on the Texas Pacific, Engineer Jones and a brakeman and J. E. Henderson, of Dallas, a telegraph line contractor, were killed.

The Sultan has telegraphed the Bey, instructing him to refuse to entertain any proposal of a French protectorate, if offered, and refer France to the Porte.

The sloop of war *Doterel* was totally destroyed and sunk. It is supposed the boiler burst and exploded the magazine. The victims number eight officers and 125 men killed.

Billie the Kid, after his escape from Lincoln, murdered William Matthews, who was a witness at the Kid's trial, and during the Lincoln County war shot him in the thigh.

A building connected with the Maplewood Hotel property, N. H., raised twenty feet to construct a story under it, fell this afternoon upon a gang of workmen, killing two men.

Henry Ward Beecher, was served with a summons to answer a suit against him by the Western Maryland Agricultural Fair for failing to lecture before the fair last October, as per contract.

The Governor of Moscow has considerably increased the stringency of the regulations relative to douniks, so as to prevent lodging houses from harboring any persons without the knowledge of the police.

A duel has taken place at Vesinet, France, between Malato, an Italian, and Pons, a Frenchman, both fencing masters, arising from a quarrel in a fencing school. Malato was wounded in the hand and wrist.

Ah Sing, steward of the ship *Anahua* from Manila, has brought suit in the marine court of New York, to recover \$2,000 damages from Captain Lunt for unlawfully depriving him of his liberty and rights.
