Justice Cahoon on July 21st, at Ogden, Utah, where he presided over the trial of William H. Hargrove, charged with the murder of John H. Hargrove, his brother. The trial was held in the court of the United States for the District of Utah, at Ogden, Utah.

TO TEST AN ORDINANCE.

Justice Cahoon of the police court was busy yesterday disposing of several cases which came before him. The most interesting of these was that of William Hargrove vs. H. M. Hargrove. This was a case in which Hargrove was charged with violating the ordinance which requires the water company to have a main report to the fire chief of each fire that a good pressure of water may be maintained. When the case was argued and submitted, the judge held that the ordinance was valid and that the water company was liable for the damage done to the Hargrove property.

The U. S. grand jury was impaneled yesterday with the following named gentlemen: James H. Hall, William Hargrove, Robert Hargrove, George H. Hargrove, John Hargrove, Daniel Hargrove, Frank Hargrove, Charles A. Hargrove, Adam Hargrove, L. A. Hargrove, W. Hargrove, P. L. Hargrove and S. Hargrove. It is expected that the grand jury will be in session a week before completing their labors.

A Chicken Case.
Phil Ford was before his home Justice Cahoon on the charge of chicken stealing, preferred by William Hargrove. The chicken, valued at three dollars, was found in the yard of the defendant. The judge held that the defendant was guilty and sentenced him to pay the value of the chicken.

Police Court Doings.
David Jenkins, who was arrested Wednesday on the charge of assault and battery on the person of Mrs. Elizabeth Hargrove, was fined \$10. It was proven that the defendant had been in the house of the victim and had been in a violent mood. The judge held that the defendant was guilty and sentenced him to pay the fine.

An Attempt at Burglary.
About 2 o'clock this morning George Larkin Jr., who resides on Mission street, was awakened by some noise coming from the kitchen at the rear of the building. It is evident the fellow was not there for any good reason, and the noise was made by the defendant. The judge held that the defendant was guilty and sentenced him to pay the fine.
