CITY COUNCIL.

A petition was submitted from Dr. Higgins Davis, of Mount City, stating that this being the year of jubilee and thanksgiving in the Church, he desired to humbly lay before the Council a few facts, well known to Mr. Cannon of the 15th Ward, the former attendant, nurse and cook in the City Hospital, who had been at Fort Douglas. Some years ago he (Dr. Higgins Davis) was engaged to attend the city patients at the Hospital aforesaid, and while so doing, an accident occurred to him which has injured him very materially, in fact so materially that he can do but little professional traveling. He is now 70 years of age, and respectfully solicited that the Council grant him the small pension aid him in his declining years, and as to his general character and circumstances, the doctor referred with pride to the presence of Samuel Cannon, the petition was received and laid on the table.

An order of the County Court of Salt Lake County, dated July 20th, 1880, was presented stating that whereas, it had been alleged that the dam in the river Jordan, which was constructed for the purpose of raising the water to a sufficient height to supply the canal on either side of said river, would cause the Jordan River to be the only outlet, to overflow and submerge the lands in places adjacent to the shore of said lake, to the injury of the owners thereof, therefore it had been ordered by the County Court aforesaid, that Isaac M. Spencer, George Nelson, Samuel Bennion and Geo. M. Spencer, be appointed a committee to act in conjunction with Gen. J. W. Fox, the chief engineer of the various canals conveying water from the Jordan to irrigate agricultural lands in Salt Lake County, and that this committee make a thorough examination of said lake at the present stage of the water, and ascertain by actual measurement how much higher, if any, the water is raised in case of an emergency, without material injury to the owners of land along the shore, etc. Inasmuch as the corporation of Salt Lake City is deeply interested in the permanency of this natural reservoir, the corporate authorities were respectfully and specially requested to appoint a delegation to accompany the committee, and join with them in making the proposed investigation.

On motion the Council decided to appoint a committee to consist of two, to act in conjunction with the delegation from the county, as requested, the naming of which committee was left with the Mayor.

The Mayor named Aldermen Dinwoodey and Sheets as said committee, and afterwards, on motion, the Mayor was added to the committee, making it a delegation of three instead of two.

The committee in finance, to whom was referred the monthly report of the committee on construction of the Jordan and Salt Lake City Canal for June, reported that they had examined the vouchers and expenditures, etc., found the same correct, and recommended the placing on file of the report and its accompanying vouchers. Adopted.

The Recorder stated that Mr. Martin H. Peck, city assessor of weights and measures, had rendered his fourth report, giving a detailed statement of all the scales tested by him. Since the last previous report, 559 scales had been attested, viz: 1 truck, 24 hay, 142 platform, 111 family Union, 153 counter balance, 57 beam, 48 spring balance, 23 spring table, etc.

An ordinance in relation to pin alleys, which had been laid upon the table as unfinished business since March 24, 1880, was taken up and regularly passed. This ordinance fixes the license for pin alleys at \$10 for each runway, and each additional alley or runway \$5.

"Still They Come."—Accounts of how the 24th was celebrated in the various settlements are still coming in. At Ephraim, 50 guns were fired at sunrise, in honor of the year of jubilee, and the stars and stripes were unfurled. At 9 a.m., a procession was formed approaching in character, if not in magnitude, to that which took place here, there being the pioneers, nationalities, 24 young ladies and an equal number of young men, Sunday Schools, contrasted representations of Utah in 1847 and 1880, and the various trades and occupations marching in the line. After parading the streets for some time, the multitude repaired to the Bowery, and the remainder of the forenoon was spent there in an agreeable manner. Bishop Dorrus was orator of the day, and besides him, others made short speeches, full of interest and instruction. Singing by the choir was also a pleasing feature of the occasion. In the evening, a dance was given.

At Spring City, at 5 a.m., a salute was fired, and at half-past 8, a musical salute was given by the brass band, preparatory to forming the procession under the direction of Rasmus Justison, marshal of the day. The procession marched through the main streets to lively airs by the brass band, after which the people were seated in the meeting-house, which had been decorated for the occasion by the sisters of the Relief Society. The opening anthem was "The Good and the True," after which prayer was offered by the chaplain, J. Robinson; then a psalm, "We are Soldiers, One and All." The oration was rendered by C. G. Larson; the remainder of the programme consisted of songs, dialogues, recitations, dialogues and short speeches. The afternoon was spent in foot races and other games, and in the evening a public dance was held. Everything passed off peacefully and successfully.

Our St. George correspondent writes a brief prospectus on the morning of the 24th, and promises a full report of the proceedings, next day.

The Damage Repaired.—The washout on the Utah Southern was more serious than at first supposed. The train was stopped near Lehi by one break in the track, but it was afterward ascertained that the track on this side of the Point had also been displaced. It appears that the cloud burst on the top of the mountain and the stream ran down both sides, and the damage in both places. The train was stopped, and did not arrive here last night at all. Bishop Sharp went down the road yesterday afternoon and supervised the men disposing the lumber at the washout, and the train was finally repaired, and the road was finally opened, and the train arrived in this city between 8 and 10 o'clock this morning.
