The defendant was sent to the Reform School instead of the Penitentiary.

Judge Anderson remarked that it was a pretty risky proceeding for a man to fill himself with whisky, put on a gun, and go and assault a respectable person in the way the defendant and his co-defendant did.

He said that he had seen the defendant himself take a long term of imprisonment.

The defendant giving his solemn promise to avoid bad company in future and lead an honest life, he was released to be detained in the Reform School till he attains his majority.

In regard to Uley, Attorney Ferguson said this man is first class, and he would not have done what he did had he not been so thoroughly intoxicated. He was only nineteen years of age.

The defendant was sentenced to three years imprisonment in the penitentiary.
