Lying in the center of one of the rich agricultural districts of the Union,


Provo's population is 9,000, with three banks, representing a capitalization of \$100,000, having completed the extension of its waterworks system, a cost of \$60,000, to the springs in Provo canyon about one-half mile from the river, thus replacing the river water with pure, clear and ice cold water, as a stranger remarked while drinking from the public fountain to a bystander, "Where do they keep the best?"

PROCTOR ACADEMY.

The Proctor academy, the other denominational school, is under the auspices of the Congregational Educational society of Provo, whose enrollment is 300 with a corps of eight teachers and instructors.

PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Having four public school buildings representing about \$60,000 with 38 classes rooms. The school enrollment is 1,612 with a corps of 37 teachers. That the school authorities and teachers are energetic and competent and are second to none in the state, is shown by the fact that from the world's fair held in Chicago, they were awarded a medal and a certificate of special mention for work done in the state fair in 1899, out of the 16 prizes competed for, Provo's schools captured

station, a distance of about six miles, to enable it to give the best of service.

BIG POWER ENTERPRISE.

The Telluride Power company furnishes power to all the mines and mills of Eureka, Brigham, Millcreek, and West Jordan, with that at Logan, and West Jordan. These three plants are connected by duplicate lines 100 miles in length and are operating in unison through over 200 miles of transmission. The Olmstead plant and works covering about 30 acres, are located at the mouth of Provo canyon, where beauti-

Numerous small yachts and launches are to be obtained and used all summer during the spring and summer and autumn months. To visit all points of interest upon the lake, experienced boatmen are on hand, thus insuring safety.

If one desires some other sport, such as fishing in a running stream where the waters are teeming with mountain trout and herring, and with a little knowledge in the art of angling he can have his wish gratified by taking himself to the banks of Provo river in Provo canyon. Here also he may enjoy the heat of the summer sun—in fact, it is an ideal spot.

The Utah fish commissioner has stocked the stream with fish. The mountains in close proximity offer every inducement to lovers of the gun.

COOL SUMMER AND HEAVY PRECIPITATION MARKS YEAR'S WEATHER CHART.

NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVEN has not been noted for any special meteorological disturbances. In general, the year has been uneventful, in marked contrast with the record of the previous year, when the most destructive wind storm, the winter of 1900-01, occurred Saturday night and Sunday, Oct. 20 and 21, blowing steadily for 14 hours and the velocity reaching 60 miles an hour. Over 100 immense shade trees, carrying tons of soil were blown across the streets, amid tangles of electric light wires and broken poles. Dozens of large buildings were unroofed, railroad cars were blown over, the costly east window of the First Presbyterian church was wrecked, and great damage done over the northern part of the state. The weather maps of that Saturday and Monday showed an immense high pressure area advancing over the Rocky mountains, with a very steep gradient to the southwest into deep atmospheric low pressure areas over the southern latitudes. Under these circumstances the air from the high altitude into the low at a high rate of speed.

The feature of the year may be said to have been the unusually cold June and the excessive precipitation of last winter and spring, which sent the level of the great lake up to two feet above what was the previous year; and the indications are that with this winter's precipitation the level will be from one to two feet higher next June than it is now. The summer was mild as to thermometer, and the fall has been a beautiful open season—pleasant to the pedestrian, but not so agreeable to tradesmen in certain lines of goods, the sale of which depends on an early start and plenty of cold, if not stormy weather. There was an abundance of water for all purposes, and the customary notices halting watering of lawns was not issued this summer. Utah lake has been more than full, the water running over Battle Creek flats, and leaving Comanche point two feet beneath the surface. There have been no early snows in the mountains this fall, of any noticeable size, but the first snows came late in October. The value of the timber in the state has continued to maintain its high rating for an equal climate this year, when there were extremes in other sections of the country. There was one exception, however the month of June, which was the coldest on record.

For January there was a pronounced dearth of sunshine, with warm southerly winds over the state, the latter part of the month, making average temperatures above the seasonal average. Storms were frequent the first half of the month, with an unusually heavy snowfall in the mountains, which, however, was melted by the warm winds later. As the ground was frozen, the melting water soaked and seeped into the earth. The mean temperature was about the same as the highest mean being 42.2 degrees at Beaver, the lowest was 18.2 degrees at Duchesne. The precipitation was 2.39 inches, or 1.39 above the normal, so the water supply was considered satisfactory.
