There must be some adequate provision of law if there is to be any solution of this problem and in default of this pro-vision the present faulty law must be enforced. #### HITCHCOCK'S ORDER.

In Secy, Hitchcock's order the instruc-tions to all special agents of the land office regarding the enforcement of the law to prohibit the enclosing of govern-ment lands for private purposes are amended so as to read as follows: "It shall be the duty of the special agent, on receipt of any charge or com-plaint, or upon information being ac-quired by him from any source that an unlawful enclosure is being maintained by any person or persons, association by any person or persons, association or corporation, at once to proceed to or corporation, at once to proceed to secure sufficient data, including a de-scription of the lands enclosed with rea-sonable certainty, not necessarily by metes and bounds nor by governmental subdivisions of surveyed lands, but only that the enclosure may be identified and the person or persons guilty of the violation as nearly as may be and by violation, as nearly as may be, and by description if the name cannot, on rea-sonable inquiry, be ascertained, and at once to submit such case, with the data thus obtained, to the United States atthus obtained, to the United States at-torney for prosecution. "It shall be the duty of the special agent, and he shall be so instructed, to be alert and vigilant to detect the ex-istence of unlawful enclosures in his district, and to proceed in accordance therewith as hereinabove directed, and that he is not to construe his duties as requiring that, before proceeding in the matter of an unlawful enclosure. first must be filed with him a formal complaint by some person or persons acquainted with the facts, but it shall be his duty, as hereinabove stated, to take the initiative action."
