Declared Constitutional by the U. S. Supreme Court.

A BLOW AT RELIGIOUS LIBERTY.

"Mormons" May be Disfranchised for Membership in the Church.

The following dispatch was received this afternoon:

WASHINGTON, Feb. 2.—The Supreme Court of the United States today rendered an opinion affirming the constitutionality of the test oath, which is intended to prevent the "Mormons" from voting.

The case came up on an application for a writ of habeas corpus made by Samuel D. Davis, who is a member of the "Mormon" Church.

Having been sentenced for unlawfully taking the prescribed test oath when he was a member of the "Mormon" Church, the court denies the application for a writ of habeas corpus, holding that polygamy is a crime, and that the constitutional provision guaranteeing freedom of religion is not intended to protect the membership of a person who, in violation of the law, commits a crime in the eyes of the state.

Samuel D. Davis was not a polygamist, but simply a member of the "Mormon" Church.
