The passengers in the Shor Line Pullman, though rudely awakened suffered no damage, and beyond their seven hours delay, necessary to get a wrecking car from Rawlins to pull the cars back upon the ralls, they sustained no inconvenience, and at 10 o'clock left Cheyenne on their way to Chicago.

QUESTION OF ASSESSMENT.

Westervelt Gives Opinion on the Utah Light & Power Co's Taxes.

Upon request of County Assessor Ben R. Eldredge, an opinion has been prepared by County Attorney Westervelt in regard to the power of the assessor to make the assessment upon the property of the Utah Light & Railway company lying within this county, instead of allowing the state board of equalization to make the assessment.

The consolidation of the Utah Light & Power company and the Consolidated Railway & Power company is responsible for the question being raised. Heretofore the property of the Utah Light & Power company has been assessed by the county and that of the Consolidated Railway & Power company by the state board of equalization. When the two companies were merged the question arose as to which of the authorities should make the assessment upon the new company. County Attorney Wes-tervelt holds that the power of levying the tax on the new company lies with the county and not with the state board of equalization. It is also declared in the opinion that
