THE ENTERING TACTS.

New Month. New Action not Apparent.

May 19, 1896.—The Washington special says there is no doubt whatever the President Hayes and Secretary Evans are greatly displeased the Secretary Thompson should have entered hands with DeLassagne in the Panama canal enterprise, in the way he has done. They neither they nor his mother have been offered a position if he had not been a member of the Cabinet. It is said that Hayes has suggested to Thompson to resign from New York immediately, which will do little satisfaction. They make no real difference at the navy department. 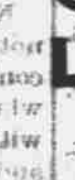

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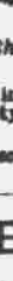
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
