

A VISIT TO SALT LAKE.

A Pleasant Ride Over the Salt Lake & Los Angeles Road.

A LOT OF SURPRISED CITY SOLOONS.

More Than \$200,000 Being Spent in Improvements—Banquet at the Beach.

In response to an invitation from the Salt Lake & Los Angeles railway company a majority of the members of the City Council went out to Salt Lake yesterday afternoon to inspect the magnitude of the improvements. A special train under the direction of General Manager Noyes, left the city at 10 o'clock. The party was composed of the following: Mayor Clayton, J. C. Carter, H. J. Stone, H. A. Hoss, J. W. Skinner, James Quinn, C. T. McArthur, J. C. Swan.

Chief of Police C. E. King, Superintendent of the city railroad company, R. G. Taylor, M. Hopkins, W. J. Stewart, F. J. Heath, R. C. Simon, H. B. Ensign, John C. Ensign, Thos. Carter, F. H. Schoppe, E. G. Fries and George Wallace Williams.

At the above gentlemen left the City Hall at 1:30 on special street cars gratuitously furnished by the city railway company. The general manager of the Salt Lake & Los Angeles company was escorted by the entire downtown street car and fifteen minutes later the train in the Lake commenced. A stop was made about five miles west of the city to allow the inspection of a piece of realty offered as a site for the proposed copper railway. Salt Lake was reached about 3 o'clock. The number of people could be plainly seen several miles out on the prairie. Its magnificent proportions were, however, not fully realized until the train stopped near the shore and feet from shore. Then many were the exclamations of admiration and surprise by the visitors. They had heard and read somewhat of the great amount of money that was being spent at Salt Lake in the erection of a pavilion and apparatus, but were not at all prepared to see what they saw. "It's amazing what can be done with \$200,000," said one of the councilmen.

The train was abandoned when the stop was made and the party headed by Manager Clayton and Architect Ketting walked over the approach, a distance of several hundred feet, to the place where piles are being driven for the great pavilion and bath house, a full and minute inspection of the work appeared in the News on January 1 last. About forty men were engaged in the driving. The pavilion and bath house were two large engines set upon flat tracks. The pile driving will be finished in about two weeks more, when a force of 500 to 600 men will be employed in the pavilion and bath house, which, according to contract, must be complete and ready for use on December 1. Mr. Clayton says he is satisfied this will be done.

At the boarding house, where the visitors were treated to a fine repast, a number of the councilmen were present. The return trip of fourteen miles was made in seventeen minutes, including one stop.

Manager Clayton was unanimously declared to be an excellent entertainer, his brother-in-law, secretary and treasurer, an able assistant, the Salt Lake and Los Angeles railroad an unequalled success and the great pavilion a large piece of architectural beauty and great good.

A FIVE CENT FARE.
