Household Hints—How to Deal

with Them.

Mr. William Steele is not the only person in the country whose troubles from the encroachment of insects and animals to inspire a wish for the invention of some infernal machine to exterminate such pests as sand flies, fleas, etc. But it seems to me, that the dissemination of science and a better knowledge of entomology are what is most needed in this direction.

I have not seen a bed-bug or a flea in my house for many years. If an army of them were to be brought in, mercury would speedily exterminate them, but I think cleanliness the best and perhaps the only preventive. The common house fly I do not molest, believing that it more than compensates for its trouble by clearing the atmosphere of miasma, and the animalcules which always arise from the putrefaction of decaying substances during warm weather.

So, I leave the birds, which are quite numerous here during the summer, instead of shooting them, or setting up scarecrows to frighten them away, I throw out some possible insecticide for them to feed their nests in from fruit trees.

The birds capture a large share of the insects, and the farmer, by feeding them, is always sure to be on hand in force in the season of fruit, whether they come early enough to take the worms or not.
