EVENING NEWS. CHRONOLOGICAL CALENDAR.

FOR THE WEEK COMMENCING AUGUST 3RD, 1884. PREPARED BY ANDREW JENSON. Sunday, August 3d. 1402-Christopher Columbus sailed on board the Santa Maria to discover the new world.

Monday, 4th. 1704-Gibraltar was taken by the English. 1881-The fifth conference of the Church and the land of Zion, was held in the land of Zion, Jackson County, Mo.

Tuesday, 5th. 70-The Temple in Jerusalem was burned by Titus. 1840-The present site of Mantel, Sanpete County, was founded by Joseph Smith.

Wednesday, 6th. 1838-Persecutions were renewed against the Saints in Missouri, at the election in Gallatin, Davies County, Mo. 1844-Apostles B. Young, H. C. Kimball, L. W. H. H. Pratt and W. Woodruff arrived in Nauvoo from their missions to the East.

Thursday, 7th. 1831-The first funeral took place in the land of Zion (Jackson County, Mo.), being the interment of Polly Knight, wife of Joseph Knight, Sen. 1841-Don Carlos Smith, youngest brother of the Prophet Joseph, died at Independence, Mo.

Friday, 8th. 1830-John Taylor and W. Woodruff started from Nauvoo, on their mission to the East. 1842-Joseph Smith was arrested by a mob of men from the city of Independence, Mo., and taken to the jail of that city.

Saturday, 9th. 1831-Joseph Smith, Jun., in company with ten elders, left Independence, Mo., for Kirtland, Ohio. 1832-Joseph Smith, Jun., was taken to the jail of that city, and held there for several days.
