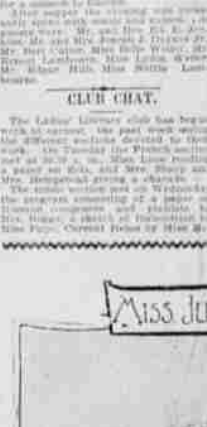




MISS JULIA GRANT
