

## ACTOR FOLKS GO FISHING

### Wild Adventures of a Party of Fourteen in Parley's Canyon.

## GOT INTO TROUBLE EARLY.

Story of a Bally Hoo, Man With a Gun and Cruel Slaughter Among The Trout.

With the opening of the fishing season comes stories galore of adventures on the part of city folk bent on securing the speckled beauties in the canyon streams of Utah. ## WIERD EXHIBITION.

At daybreak the party descended upon the stream and commenced to "fish." Unkind critics affirm that it was the weirdest exhibition witnessed in Utah canyon. Joe O'Meara, actor, with curly locks, stepped on a boulder and sat down thoughtfully in mid-stream. Then J. H. Bennett made a lovely cast and his line dipped back, each with a story of the fish he had lost. Finally big Joe Green arrived triumphantly bearing a trout which measured exactly 24 inches from bow to stern. Then came J. H. Bennett with four small ones, but it was Col. Greenwald who had the day with it.

Then all hands were confronted with the problem of dividing 14 fish among 14 hungry men. In the meantime the leading horse, utterly exhausted, had fallen asleep. The problem was solved—each man ate a fish and Mr. Phillips got the bones.

The return to town was not devoid of incidents and the exhausted actors arrived at the theater just in time to find their paint and paintbrushes go through their parts.

That is the reason the performance last night was not of the smoothest.
