

Wheat was knee high, and some of the heads were beginning to show. Col. Smith brought several specimens of an excellent quality of the micaceous oxide of iron ore, found in abundance on the east slope of the east range of the Salmon River mountains, and mixed with quartz and mica or talc slate.
