

## THE CULLEN CLOSES.

Its Proprietor, S. C. Ewing, Makes an Assignment.

THE LIABILITIES ARE \$47,211.29.

George Collins, Tenant or Assignee—  
The Assets Include Valuable  
Properties.

The big Cullen hotel, owned by Matt Cullen, and operated under lease by Sam C. Ewing, is in the hands of its assigns. The assignment was made this afternoon, and George Collins, the assignee, was named as assignee, and took hold of the premises in the interest of the creditors.

There are three classes of the hotel's assets: one used of management. The first class of the expenses of the hotel and bar, thirty-eight in number. The aggregate indebtedness to these sum totals \$47,211. The second class aggregates \$20,000, and the various parties concerned and others, \$10,000 in total.

The total amount of liabilities is \$77,211. The amount of the assets when the assignment was made aggregated, giving a full list of credits this amount.

The assets consist of two accounts, bill receivable, mining stock, real estate, and fixtures, the value of which is considerably in excess of the liabilities.
