Three California Girls.

Not the least of California's remarkable products is the girl. In the future her people, particularly her girls, in 1910 a woman, Mrs. Klumpke, arrived in Paris with her four young daughters, born in San Francisco. They were well educated, but had been brought to Europe from San Francisco for the purpose of developing and training the talent these high spirited girls felt they possessed.

The young artist, however, able to add to her income, she has exhibited pictures in the French salon every year since 1882, and received honorable mentions and a medal.

The third sister, Devonia Klumpke, was naturally a mathematician. She was her father's specialty, including algebra, she attended the great university of the Sorbonne and studied indefatigably. Besides her mathematical attainments she was a brilliant scholar in English, French, German, Latin and Greek. She is the first woman student ever admitted to the Paris observatory. Her skill in taking observations of the stars is so notable that she is employed as one of the French government astronomical observers.

The fourth sister has already made great progress as a musician. No wonder European countries admire American girls remarkable.

Repeat Notes.

The repeated use of warm baths has come down from ancient times. The water generally contained medicinal constituents in natural solution, but the relief, in many cases, was doubtless due solely, or mainly, to the temperature, with a wooden bath. Equal benefit is derived from such an application in many forms of leishmaniasis. The best thing to do with a sprained limb is to immerse the foot in water as hot as can be borne. A crushed foot or hand may be similarly treated until the arrival of a surgeon, the hot water being frequently renewed.

A correspondent in The Medical Record, Oct. 4, 1893, advises the warm bath for infants suffering from intestinal colic.

The writer says that he has had to try this remedy in a case of colic, accompanied by extreme restlessness and pain and considerable diarrhoea, because of the failure of all usual treatments. The trouble had continued several weeks, and the child had become much emaciated. Finally had been tried without success.

At length, fearing that the child might go into convulsions, the doctor ordered a tub of hot water, of a temperature of 90 degs. Fahrenheit. While the child was immersed in this, his head was kept cool with cloths wetting out of cold water. The doctor says:

"The effect was magical. Within ten or fifteen minutes the child quieted down, and on being taken from the bath fell into a quiet, healthy sleep, which lasted several hours. The infant returned from that time began to get well. The mother and nurse, having learned the value of the hot bath, resorted to it afterward, whenever the child was distressed, with the exception of one day, after which the child had entirely recovered."
