

had created for my husband and myself, I refused to do as I was asked. I was then worried for days by several people, and I was finally threatened that if I did not furnish these facts and items they would publish a statement for me, which was finally done against my consent, and with my more than unqualified disapproval.

It is also stated in Sunday morning's issue of the same paper that I had been kidnapped on Saturday, to prevent my appearing before the grand jury. The facts are, I did not know the whereabouts of my husband, and, believing he was in American Fork, I went there to look for him, returning with him on Sunday morning. I am deeply sorry that my suspicions should have induced me to have taken a course whereby I have brought upon my brethren and sisters, my husband, and myself unmerited odium, and my only desire in writing this is to acquaint the public with the facts of the case and leave them to judge for themselves concerning the issue.

In closing this communication, it would be well for me to state that it was my own proposal to write this and have it published, and that no person, directly, or indirectly, has either coaxed, threatened or influenced me to do so.

Apologizing for this lengthy communication, and trusting, as I said before, that, in the interests of justice, you will insert this, believe me to remain,

Cure for Diphtheria.
SALT LAKE CITY,
Nov. 5, 1878.

Editors Deseret News:

I am sorry that there is not a better understanding of that direful disease, diphtheria, than there seems to be in this city. Now there are six different types of that disease all requiring different kinds of treatment; no two types can be cured by the same medicine and all complications must be taken into consideration and treated accordingly.

For the benefit of the sufferer I will give a treatment for diphtheria complicated with croup, the most dangerous type of that disease. Take tincture of phytolacca 4 oz., tincture of valerian 4 oz., distilled water, 4 oz., mix, dose one teaspoonful every 30 to 60 minutes according to the severity of the case. In case of great debility from the poisoned state of the blood and the throat is ulcerated badly, take hydrochloric acid dilute, saturated solution of chlorate of potash of each one oz., mix, dose two drops in water every hour, using as a wash to the throat permanganate of potash 10 grs, tincture of balladonna five drops water 4 oz., mix.
