**Roumania Will Declare Her Independence.**

**NEW YORK, 23.—**Herian's News Agency received the following cable to day:

**London.**

A dispatch from Bucharest states that Roumania has resolved upon declaring her independence.

The government relinquishes all claim upon European protection, replacing it with Russia. A proclamation is about to be issued proclaiming Prince Charles King of Roumania.

The army will be mobilized and a paper currency issued.

The dispatch creates great excitement. It is generally considered here that this act by Roumania will retard, and perhaps break off entirely, the negotiations for peace.

The City Council shall also appoint a Superintendent of the Waterworks, an Assessor of Water Rates, and such other officers as may be necessary to carry on the works. All officers so appointed shall hold office during the pleasure of said Council.
