## THE RECOUNT OF BALLOTS COMPLETE

Little Change Shown Aside from the Great Number of Challenged Votes.

## VALIDITY OF CHALLENGES.

Now Being Argued—Republican Committee Makes Recommendations—A. O. U. W. Reception.

Odgen, Utah, March 2.—At 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon Judge Morse completed the preliminary recount of the ballots in the election judgeship contest case of Daniel Hanner against J. A. Howell. The trial has been in progress 24 days, and just two weeks of this time was occupied in going over the ballots.

If none of the challenged ballots be rejected finally, each of the candidates gains by the recount, Howell 15 and Relap 5. This arises from the fact that in going over the ballots in the recount a total of 22 were found in the various packages which had been omitted in the count of the judges.

In response to a request from Judge Magnants the court outlined the position he would take and the method he would employ in passing on the challenged ballots. He will handle each challenged ballot again and require each side to state whether they wished to press the challenge. He thought it possible that in some cases counsel might voluntarily withdraw the challenges. This will be allowed, but the action will be taken on the ballots individually and not in groups.

Judge Powers then began his argument to the court on the validity of the various challenges made by the contestants. He read from the election law of the state, showing the various safeguards intended to make the ballot a secret one. The provisions were that no ballot should be defaced, stained or soiled in any way. A voter was at every stage of the act of recording his choice safeguarded as to his rights. He was furnished with instructions how and where he must mark his ballot to have it recorded. He might if a ballot was spoiled or soiled, get another ballot, but he could not record a ballot if a man could not record his choice after three trials must be regarded as one who should not have the right to vote. Judge Powers had not concluded his argument when the court adjourned.

## REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE.
