

BIG TRACK MEET BY VARSITY

On Muddy Track McAllister Was
Too Much for Young
Brinton.

B. Y. U. TEAM CAME IN SECOND.

In High Jump, Pole Vault and Hammer
Throw McAllister's Men Had
Everything Their Own Way.

The results of the big state track and
field meet on Cummings field Saturday
afternoon were as follows:

University of Utah, 494;
Brigham Young University, 27;
Agricultural College, 25;
Batterday State University, 14;
Brigham Young College, 1.

Probably 2,000 persons braved the cold
to witness the big track meet and despite
the unfavorable conditions prevailing they
seemed well satisfied with the contests
which decided the state championship.

The soft track and field presented the
young athletes from doing their best and
while there were some disappointments
the meet was a success.

It was expected that the 100 and 200-yard
dashes would bring out a sensational con-
test between Brinton of the U. of U. and
McAllister of the L. D. S. U., but the
heavy track proved the undoing of McAd-
docks' younger brother in the first event.

McAllister did not qualify, and in the latter
McAllister won by at least 10 feet. For a
short distance Brinton made a good run
but his strength left him and he could not
keep up the pace. It should be taken into
consideration that Brinton is only 17
years of age, and that he has had but
little experience in track meets.

With proper care and good coaching the
youngster will make the fastest of them
do their best to beat him.

In the long distance events the Aggies
and B. Y. U. divided honors. In the mile
run Hanson carried off the honors with
but little trouble.

Where the U. of U. excelled was in the
high jump, pole vault and hammer
throw, taking all these events with ease.

Baird of the B. Y. U. won the broad
jump by a good margin.

are posted on the game. Big purses will
be offered at each meet and the programs
will be made up of interesting events.

All the fastest riders of the world, or
nearly all of them, will be here for the

the big money. The season with its
