### A THRILLING RUNAWAY.

The horses, however, did not stop, and the carriage was hurled into the air. The ladies realizing that the carriage was going into the pile of rocks and was going to be crushed, jumped from the carriage. Mr. Green held to the horses until he came to the bottom of the hill where the carriage tongue struck in the ground. The horses were taken to the side walk. They were terrified and all escaped any serious injuries, but were considerably bruised, especially the children.
